

## Script for Call to Action—Contact Your State Senator! This Week's Slate of Voter Suppression

Hello friends. If you haven't heard, the Republicans in the Senate are voting this week on a slate of voter suppression bills. Despite absolutely no evidence of voter fraud, Senate Republicans are about to pass new voting restrictions, making it much harder for everyone in Kansas to vote, especially marginalized and underserved voters. These newest voting restrictions, which target voters who vote by mail, are unnecessary, overreaching, and harmful to all Kansas voters. The bills are likely to go to conference committee by Friday. Please call, email, or text your Kansas Senator and Representative *this week* asking that they vote against these restrictive bills, and tell your family and friends to do the same. If you don't know your state senator, go to [ksleglookup.org](http://ksleglookup.org). Also, while a letter from a non-constituent isn't as powerful as a letter from a constituent, feel free to contact other state senators and representatives who are not yours. For example, Representative Neelly (R) has part of Eudora in his district. Let's put some pressure on Republicans.

Unfortunately, in all likelihood, the Republican Senate will pass these voting restriction bills this week, but they still need to hear from you now. Then, when the bills get to the Governor's desk, she'll likely veto the bills, and that's when the real work will begin. I'll ask you to contact your state senators and representatives *again*, asking they vote to sustain the Governor's veto of these bills, and to tell all your family and friends to do the same.
